Thank you for purchasing a DADOquartz® product. Your confidence in purchasing this product will be rewarded with years of service.

What is DADOquartz®?

It is a unique, engineered stone innovation manufactured from quartz and other minerals mixed with resin. DADOquartz® has an attractive matt finish imparting a soft alabaster-like feel to the product. It is resistant to scratching and is thus very wear resistant. It has high heat retention that will contribute to an extended bathing experience consuming less energy. Should the product be damaged, its solid-body construction will ensure that the product is restored to its original condition after repairs.

Cleaning and maintenance

Keep your products looking good by cleaning regularly. This will reduce signs of wear and aging over the years. DADOquartz®, unlike most competing products, can readily be cleaned with gel or abrasive detergents. Take care to rinse the product's surface thoroughly after cleaning. For stubborn stains, such as that caused by ink, dyes, red wine or cigarette burns, use a green 3M ScotchBrite pad.

Preventing damage

Although DADOquartz® is exceptionally resistant to mechanical or chemical attack, do not expose the products surface for significant periods to aggressive agents like strong mineral acids, acetone, methylene trichloride. Do not apply paint strippers to the surface. Protect the product, especially sharp edges, from knocks by hard or rough objects. This may cause chips or even cracks.

Repairing damage

As DADOquartz® is a full-bodied product it is possible to remove scratches, stains and cigarette burns and restore the product's surface to its original beauty. For light or superficial damage the surface can be restored by smoothing the surface with the abrasive side of green 3M ScotchBrite sponge and an abrasive household cleaner. For chips or deeper damage a repair kit is available to fill the damaged area. Once cured, the area can be sanded with fine grained aluminum oxide sanding paper. Should the damage area still be visible repeat the process.
